## Tuition & Fee Sheet

Concordia Place strives to provide the highest care for your children and keep tuition affordable. For example, Concordia Place offers:

- Accreditation from the National Association for the Education of Young Children (NAEYC) and a Gold Circle of Excellence from ExceleRate Illinois, a statewide quality rating system
- Qualified teachers: Preschool teachers have a bachelor's degree in early childhood education plus a Type 04 Certificate; Early Learning teachers have a minimum of an associate's degree in early childhood education. Our School-Age 365 team is qualified with a minimum of 30 college credit hours, 6 of which are in education
- A proven, play-based curriculum that helps children develop social/emotional, physical, cognitive, language, mathematics, science, and the arts
- Organic meals and healthy snacks
- Enrichment activities, such as yoga, creative movement and music, and Spanish
- Dedicated large interior play spaces and outdoor play lots

We are pleased to offer families with more than one child enrolled in these Concordia programs a 5% sibling discount on the total tuition for all children.

\* **Determining Household Income:** Tuition is based on your child's program, the total **gross** income for your household and family size. For each additional child in your family, we give a \$5,000 consideration to determine the tuition category. If your income is less than \$75,000, you must provide a copy of your most recent IRS Tax Statement and /or proof of income; otherwise your tuition is the highest category.

Also Note:

- We accept subsidies through IDHS (Action for Children). Families with these subsidies also pay \$20 per child per week in addition to their IDHS co-pay amount.
- Annual Registration per child is also based on total gross household income: \$150 for families > \$75,000, \$120 for families \$45,001-\$75,000, \$80 for families \$26,001-\$45,000, and \$50 for families under \$26,000
- An additional quarterly Activity Fee per child of \$50 is assessed for Two/Three and Preschool programs.
- An Activity Fee of \$120 for children in School-Age 365 Summer Camp for the full summer.
- For School-Age 365, Concordia Place extends its After School program hours to accommodate when area schools are closed during the school year. There is an additional \$15 charge for full-days and \$10 for half-day closures.
- Sibling discounts apply only to tuition and not to other fees and charges.
